## 2. General Information

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### A. STAGE DIMENSIONS/DESCRIPTIONS:

Proscenium type

Orchestra pit elevator and apron down stage

Catwalks running up stage to down stage at a height 27'6" on both stage right and left

Access to both FOH and audience from stage right and left

Stage floor is suspended yellow pine and may be lagged into

### B. ORCHESTRA PIT:

The pit in the Gunter Theatre is a hydraulic lift with mechanical locks

Operated from 2 places: stage left panel & pit loading area

Can accommodate approximately 23-30 musicians that can enter from the performance level or the trap level

Not to be used as a people mover; freight only

There is a lighted conductor's stand and raised platform available.

(100) Music stands and lights (120) Orchestra chairs (8) 30" stools available

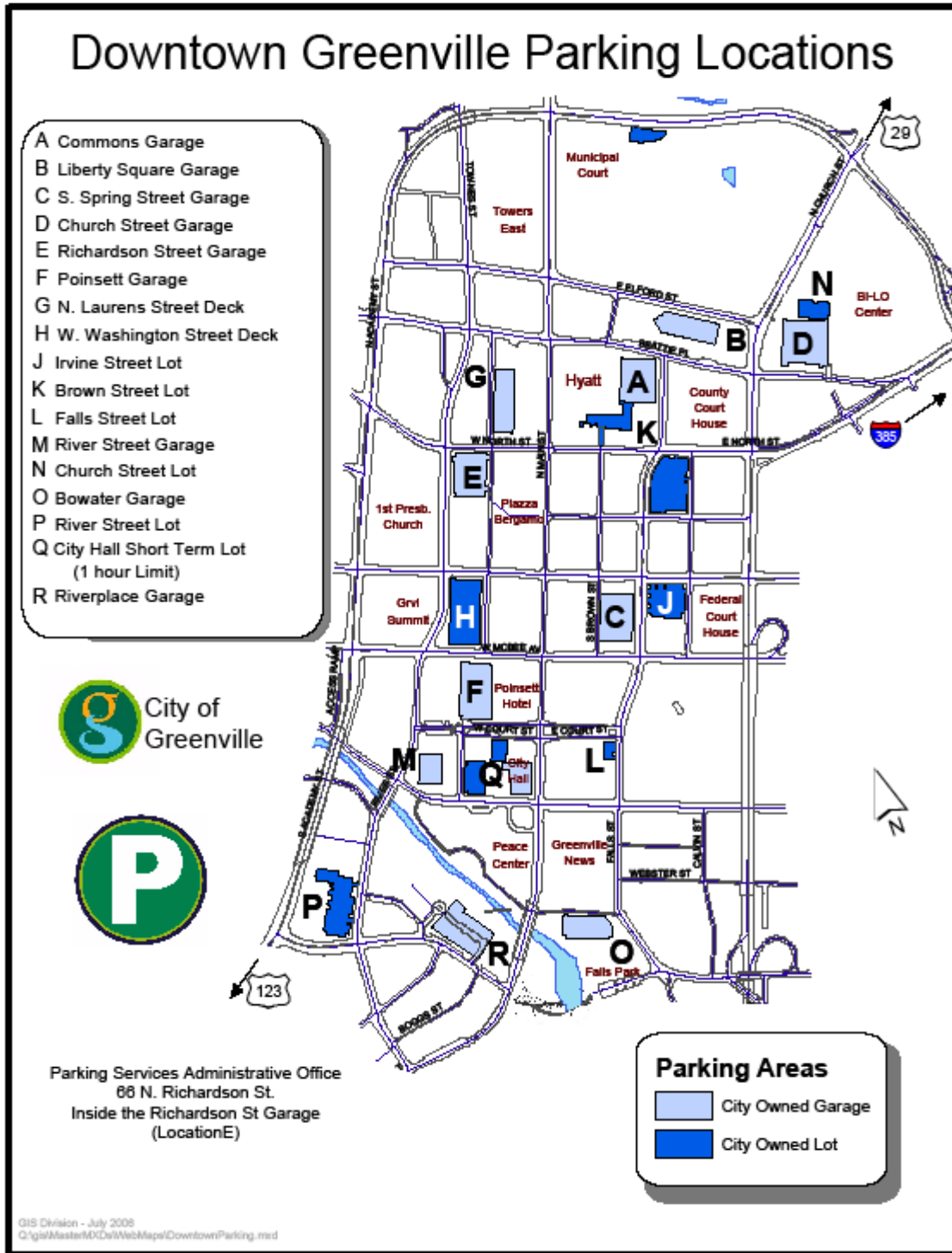
