Mr. Palminteri has more than 55 movies to his credit as an actor, writer and director including The Usual Suspects, Bullets Over Broadway (which he was nominated for an Academy Award and won the Independent Spirit Award for Best Supporting Actor), Analyze This, Hurlyburly, Mullholland Falls, Faithful (also written by Mr. Palminteri), A Guide to Recognizing Your Saints, Yonkers Joe, Jolene and, most recently, Legend starring Tom Hardy. Mr. Palminteri has had a recurring role on the hit show "Modern Family" and has starred in "Blue Bloods." He has won three Emmy Awards for the MSG Network. Mr. Palminteri directed the HBO series "Oz," Showtime's "Women vs Men" and the feature film Noel. His recent performance in A Bronx Tale marked the first time in history that the same actor has written and starred in the Broadway play, the feature film and the musical.
